It may treat issues, for example, difficulties from medical procedure, diseases, and extreme breathing issues. It involves close, constant attention by a team of specially-trained health care providers. Critical care usually takes place in an intensive care unit (ICU) or trauma centre. They work alongside doctors, nurses and other paramedical staff such as physiotherapists, dieticians and pharmacists in often pressurised conditions.
